Although the Farm Bill did not pass Congress this year, we remain laser focused working on federal priorities that will benefit your bottom line and advance U.S. aquaculture; creating an aquaculture advisory council within USDA, educating the Farm Service Agency about aquaculture production methods, achieving an aquaculture organic seal, increasing the funding for the five regional aquaculture centers, creating a waiver to the adjusted gross income limit, and creating the authority for USDA to issue bird depredation permits.


- Learn about FSA financial and environmental programs: some might benefit your farm. Visit offices.usda.gov to locate your FSA office.


Key Activities

With the Farm Bill reauthorization pending, we continue to advocate for critical aquaculture bills: HR3542 Increased USDA research funding: HR4127 Adjusted Gross Income exemption for ELAP; HR 3951 Establish USDA Office of Aquaculture.
